



#### **Primary Objectives of Dental Services in DH**

- To raise the oral health awareness of the community and provide preventive and promotive oral health care services to the public;
- To provide emergency dental service to general public and persons with special needs; and
- To provide dental services to eligible civil servants, pensioners and their dependents as the government's contractual obligation to her employees



#### **Services mainly include:**

- Civil Servants Dental Service
- Emergency Dental service
- School Dental Care Service
- Hospital Dental Service
- Community Dental Service
   (DH / other specified institutions such as NGOs participating in publicly-funded dental programmes)





#### **Civil Servants Dental Service**

- Provides general dental care to eligible civil servants/pensioners and their eligible dependents
- Multi-disciplinary specialist service
  - > Endodontics
  - ▶ Periodontics
  - Prosthodontics
  - > Family dentistry
  - Orthodontics
  - > Oral maxillofacial surgery
  - > Paediatric dentistry













#### **Emergency Dental Services (General Public Session)**

 Provide treatment of acute dental diseases, prescription for pain relief, treatment of oral abscess and teeth extraction










#### **School Dental Care Service**

# **Entry Requirements for Non-locally trained dentists**

- (a) been registered in Hong Kong under the Dentists Registration Ordinance (Cap. 156); or
- (b) been registered as a dentist under the law of a place outside Hong Kong;
  - ① at least one-year full-time post-qualification clinical experience;
  - ② have; and good command of English and be able to communicate in Chinese; and
  - ③ obtained a Limited Registration (LR; open to all dentists) or Special Registration (SR; open to specialist dentists) under the Dental Council of Hong Kong (DCHK) after receiving a conditional offer of employment from DH

#### Introducing new registration pathways: Limited Registration

- selected for full-time employment by a specified institution (DH, HA, HKU, Prince Philip Dental Hospital (PPDH) or other institutions specified by Secretary for Health); or type of employment determined and promulgated by DCHK
  - (b) obtained a qualification outside Hong Kong which is recognised by DCHK
    - (c) At least one year of relevant full-time post-qualification clinical experience
    - registered as a dentist under the law of a place outside Hong Kong (d)
- **Must satisfy DCHK that:** has not been prohibited by DCHK from taking a licensing examination (e)
  - is of good character

#### Introducing new registration pathways: Special Registration

- selected for full-time employment by a specified institution (DH, HA, HKU, PPDH or other institutions specified by Secretary for Health)
  - (b) obtained a qualification outside Hong Kong which is recognised by DCHK
    - awarded a Fellowship from Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (HKAM) in specialty of dental surgery; or certified by HKAM as having achieved a professional standard equivalent to that for the award of HKAM Fellowship
      - (d) adequate and relevant full-time post-qualification clinical experience
    - (e) registered as a dentist under the law of a place outside Hong Kong

**Must satisfy DCHK that:**

- (b) Certified by every institution(s) to have satisfactorily served with reference to DCHK's criteria
